Seoul St. Mary's Hospital has opened its Regional Maternal and Child Medical Center, designated as the only center of its kind in the Seoul metropolitan area. The center provides integrated, multidisciplinary care for high-risk mothers and newborns, covering pregnancy, delivery, postpartum care, and neonatal intensive care. Building on its expertise in complex births, including naturally conceived quintuplets and 22-week premature infants, the hospital also plans to strengthen regional care networks after discharge...
